NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* For 2017-2020 (RRS).
- 1.2 The following RRS will be changed; the Sailing Instructions may also change racing rules:
 - When the AP signal is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 45 minutes.' This changes Signal Flag AP.
 - A boat starting more than 10 minutes after the starting signal will be scored DNS. This changes RRS A4.
 - RRS A2.1 is changed to allow the exclusion of a boat's worst score if five or more races have been completed.
 - RRS Appendix V Alternative Penalties will be used. This changes RRS 44.1.
 - The time limit to deliver protests to the race office shall be no later than 60 minutes after the race committee docks. This refines RRS 61.3.
 - RRS Appendix T Arbitration will be used. This changes RRS 60.

2 ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY, AND INFORMATION

- 2.1 The Regatta is open to all boats of the Viper 640 class.
- 2.2 Boats may register and pay the regatta fee online through Thursday Sept 19 or in person at LCYC beginning Friday Sept 20.
- 2.3 Event information and registration is at lcyc.info/racing/viper_640
- 2.4 Directions to LCYC are available on the LCYC website.
- 2.5 Someone from LCYC will be at the club on Friday Sept 20 from 1000 until 2000 and Saturday morning to welcome racers, direct them to their parking spot, and take registrations and fees. LCYC has room for all anticipated cars-with-trailer. Racers expecting to arrive after 2000 Friday night should notify Dale Hyerstay of their expected time of arrival so we can have someone onsite to greet and assist you. Club grounds are open at all hours.
- 2.6 Limited housing with LCYC members may be available first-come first-served. Instructions for that and other lodging options are listed in the 'General Information' document viewable on the LCYC website.

FEES3.1 The Regatta fee is \$130 per boat and must be paid as part of Registration.

3.2 The fee includes a bagel breakfast on Saturday and Sunday, a come-as-you-are buffet dinner for skipper and two crew at the clubhouse Saturday about 1730, and cheese, crackers and hot dogs pre-departure Sunday. The meals price for additional crew and guests is \$20 each.

4 SCHEDULE OF RACES

4.1 Race Schedule (final will be in Sailing Instructions):

4.2 If the Race Committee determines that all competitors are present and ready to race, the start sequences may begin earlier than posted.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be posted on the LCYC website and the LCYC clubhouse north-side bulletin board and in print at on-site check-in Friday Sept 20 or the next morning. Any changes to the SIs will be posted at the clubhouse before 0915 on the day they will take effect.

6 RACING AREAS

Racing areas will be in Shelburne Bay where LCYC is located, or Burlington Bay to the north of the Bay, or west of Shelburne Point. An attached page shows all areas and the location of LCYC.

7 COURSES

All courses will be windward/leeward, normally with an offset at the windward mark; one to five legs of about 0.7 - 1.0 nm; a leeward gate may be used; with the exception of the gate all marks rounded to port. A course diagram is attached below.

8 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 8.1 Penalties for the infringement of the rules of Part 2 or rule 31 of the RRS shall be taken in accordance with RRS Appendix V.
- 8.2 RRS Appendix T in its entirety (Post-Race Penalties and Arbitration) will apply.

9 SCORING

9.2 One race will constitute a series. A boat's score for the series will exclude her worst finish if five or more races have been completed. This alters RRS A2.1.

- 10 RACE RADIO The Race Committee will use channel 72 for communication with the fleet.
- 11 PRIZES
- 11.1 LCYC prizes will be given for first, second, and third place.
- 11.2 Recognition will be given to the competitor team that came the farthest distance.
- 12 LAUNCHING & BERTHING

LCYC does not have a hoist, so all boats will be launched at the club's launch ramp, with on-site storage of vehicle and trailer. When not racing, boats will be tied up at the club's docks or put on members' moorings, unless unruly weather warrants hauling them out. Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with the permission of, or advisement by, the race committee.


13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY
