

Series A, B, C, D (Wednesday Night) —May-September, 2007

29.0 RULES:

Series A, B, C, and D (Wednesday night series from May to Sept.) are governed by the latest version of the *International Sailing Federation (ISAF), 2005-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) including the prescriptions of US Sailing, the event's Notice of Race, and these current year LCYC Sailing Instructions.*

30.0 RACING AREA:

The racing area may be contained within the Shelburne Bay vicinity. The start will generally be in the leeward quadrant of Shelburne Bay.

31.0 COURSE

31.1 COURSE DIAGRAMS

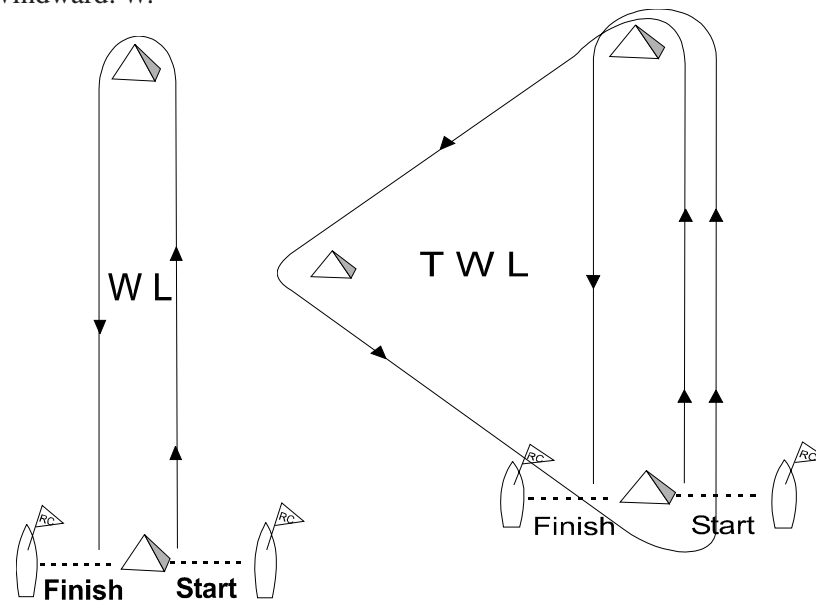
2005-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing, appendix K, *provides diagrams for race courses which LCYC has designated as follows:*

Windward-Leeward: WL.

Triangle Windward-Leeward: TWL.

Triangle: T.

Windward: W.



31.3 All Marks shall be rounded to port (course sailed counter clockwise).

31.4 The windward and/or leeward mark may be an inflatable drop mark placed by the race committee.

Depending on wind intensity and direction, the first turn mark may be “S”, “C”, “E”, “P”, or “D”.

33.0 CHECK IN:

All boats shall attempt to check-in with the race committee prior to the first warning signal.

Boats changing fleets at the beginning of any monthly series may not declare their fleet verbally to the race committee on the starting line. Boats changing fleets must provide a written declaration (via e-mail note to scorer@lcy.info or note faxed to the race scorer (802-878-3941) 1 week prior to the racing event. Should extenuating circumstances occur, written notice must be given to the PRO prior to the race - this notice shall be faxed to the race scorer on race day.

Boats changing racing fleet will be penalized 1 point per race for failure to notify the race scorer of their intended racing fleet (1 week) prior to the race event. Prior notice of changing fleets facilitates race results being posted on the Web site within 24 hours.

34.0 PRACTICE RACE:

A practice race will be held on May 23, 2007. *Sailing Instructions* will be available at the LCYC clubhouse prior to the first warning signal.
