 - 2.2.1. Discussion points:
 - 2.2.1.1. Members and guests: must wear face masks when around others or in house.
 - 2.2.1.2. Stewards will do extra cleaning
 - 2.2.1.3. Task force will continue to meet regularly, making decisions based on state
 - 2.2.1.4. No opening of house yet
 - 2.2.1.5. No ice vet
 - 2.2.1.6. Picnic tables must stay in same location, no grouping of tables
 - 2.2.1.7. Policies will be able to be modified by committee chair as needed between meetings
 - 2.2.1.8. Possible mandatory signing in of members and guests for tracking in case of outbreak. Book will be left out under awning on table.
 - 2.2.2. COVID-19 plan approved unanimously

3. Soft Opening Discussion:

- 3.1. **Docks**
 - 3.1.1. Dock social distance protocols / signage to be developed and posted on docks.
 - 3.1.2. Masks will be required on docks.



3.1.3. The spot the Dinse usually sits will be used for additional dinghies this year. Not sure where Dinse will be located yet.

3.2. Bathrooms

- 3.2.1. Bathrooms are open when stewards are on duty.
- 3.2.2. Showers are off.

3.3. Stewards

- 3.3.1. Stewards have about a week of projects, and are completing things around the club.
- 3.3.2. Stewards have a twice daily cleaning protocol of bathrooms added to their scope.
- 3.3.3. Stewards will have discretion with the details and how they feel comfortable.

3.4. Club Boats

- 3.4.1. Whaler was launched for safety purposes, should be at JR Sailing dock.
- 3.4.2. Discussion around launch service with masks required and a maximum of 4 people. Members that are medical doctors said starting launch service would be safe. The service may be discontinued depending on how members comply with rules as well as how Vermont's COVID numbers look like as the summer goes on. June 4 is the proposed start of the launch service.
- 3.4.3. Club dinghies will need to be wiped down after use.

3.5. **House & Kitchen** (these go hand in hand)

- 3.5.1. We must assume if the house is open so is the kitchen.
- 3.5.2. Propose to keep the house and kitchen closed initially, until we see how the launch service goes.
- 3.5.3. The awning will be installed next week. Stewards may help.
- 3.5.4. The Adirondack chairs will be put out next week.
- 3.5.5. Bathrooms will be cleaned each day by the cleaner.
- 3.5.6. Recycling and trash bins will be moved outside of the house.

3.6. **Grounds**

- 3.6.1. The picnic tables will be moved around the grounds in socially distant locations.
- 3.6.2. Grills will be available soon.
- 3.6.3. Discussion around whether or not to offer non-members a place to put small boats on the lawn. More details are needed before more discussion can take place.
- 3.6.4. 3 solar motion lights will be put in the north parking lot. New solar lights will also be put on the walkways

3.7. **Social**

3.7.1. Social events are cancelled until further notice. 4 weeks notice will be given for any events.

3.8. **Junior Sailing**

3.8.1. The traditional JR sailing program has been officially cancelled.



3.8.2. We will offer private lessons for 1 or 2 kids per instructor. If 2 kids are not siblings, they will be separated into different boats. 8 families have been interested so far.
