

Lake Champlain Yacht Club Steve Landau Memorial Scholarship Application

The Steve Landau Memorial Scholarship was established in 2011 in memory of long-time Lake Champlain Yacht Club board member and sailor, Steve Landau. While he did not learn to sail until he was an adult, he treasured his sailing experiences and encouraged youth to gain their sea-legs early in life.

This scholarship is intended to provide a Shelburne-area youth full tuition to attend a two-weeks of half-day sailing camps or one week of a full day sailing camp. Please note that camp sessions fill up quickly and are first-come first-serve. Every effort will be made to accommodate the scholarship winner in their preferred session. Early registration is encouraged.

Applicants should submit a registration form for two weeks of half-day sailing camp sessions or one week of a full day session found at www.lcyc.info along with this attached scholarship form.

Applicant must be:

- Age 8 +
- Be able to swim sufficiently well to pass the following swim test on the first day of camp:
 - Be able to swim unaided approximately 1 pool length and back. (The student will swim from the junior sailing dock to the swim platform and back to the dock.)
 - o Tread water unaided for 3 minutes.
 - After 3 minutes, while still in the water, the student must put on his or her life jacket (which will be provided) and fasten it.
 - With the life jacket secured, the students must swim back to the buoy and return to the dock.
