

## Water Craft Storage

These rules apply to all member owned watercraft stored on LCYC property, including “drysail” sailboats on trailers, dinghies, SUP’s, kayaks, canoes, rowing shells, sailboards and sailing dinghies. Storage of powerboats is not permitted.

Without express permission from the Grounds Chair, member owned watercraft may only be stored at the club between Opening and Closing Workdays.

Storage space for “drysail” boats and sailing dinghies is limited and will be prioritized, as necessary, for boats that are actively used.

All member owned watercraft stored at LCYC must be clearly marked with the owner’s name. Ongoing failure to do so may result in removal of said watercraft from LCYC grounds and/or loss of privileges to store watercraft at the club.

No unapproved boats on trailers or empty trailers shall be stored on LCYC grounds for more than 3 consecutive days without prior written consent from the Grounds Chair.

## Dry Sail Storage (DSS)

A sailboat less than 23’ in length may be parked on a trailer in the south parking area in a designated DSS space assigned by the Grounds Chair. An annual fee, determined by the BOG, will be assessed for each assigned DSS space. Spaces will be assigned annually by the Grounds Chair. Applications for DSS, along with the fee payment, should be sent to the Grounds Chair by May 1<sup>st</sup>.

If DSS demand exceeds capacity, spaces will be allocated based on the following priority scheme. Note: All requests received by May 1<sup>st</sup> will take priority over those received after May 1st:

- i. Sailboat owned by a member who does not currently have an assigned mooring and who was assigned a DSS spot in the prior year.
- ii. Racing sailboat\* owned by a member who does not currently have an assigned mooring.
- iii. Sailboat owned by a member who does not currently have an assigned mooring.
- iv. Racing sailboat\* owned by a member who also has an assigned mooring.
- v. Sailboat owned by a member who also has an assigned mooring assigned.

\* Note: Racing sailboat indicates a boat the owner intends to actively race

Seniority: In the event that two members fall in the same category, priority will be given to the member who has the longer tenure as LCYC member.

DSS spaces shall not be used for storage - the Grounds Chair may require that unused boats, trailers, or other equipment be removed, and LCYC reserves the right to remove them if necessary, at the owner's expense.

### Sailing Dinghies

(d) Members (and approved non member participants in the Singlehanded Dinghy program) may keep sailing dinghies less than 16' on dollies (or, with Grounds Chair approval, on small trailers) in the designated Sailing Dinghy storage area at the top of the launch ramp adjacent to the DSS lot. Sailing dinghies are boats suitable for launching by hand. All spars, blades and sails should be stored on the boat (or at home), with the exception of a limited number of Laser masts which may be stored in the Sharpie Building (see below).

### Dinghies

Should be stored on racks provided by the Club or on the bank next to the ramp. Dinghies stored on the bank next to the ramp must remain clear of the ramp.

### SUP's and Sailboards

Should be stored on one of the club owned racks, on a member owned rack or on the embankment south of the launch ramp. Storage of SUP's and Sailboards on the beach is not permitted.

### Canoes and Kayaks

Should be stored on one of the club owned racks or on the embankment on the south side of the ramp. There may be limited storage, based on personal needs, of kayaks in a designated area on the beach. A written request, with need justification, for beach storage should be made to the Grounds Chair.

### Other Watercraft

Storage of other types of watercraft (e.g. rowing shells) may be allowed, depending on space availability, but must be pre-approved by the Grounds Chair.

### Sharpie Building use

Storage in the Sharpie building is intended primarily for Club equipment. There is limited storage (first come, first serve) for rigged Laser masts from June through September for LCYC member participants in the Dinghy Racing series only. Masts should be labeled with Member's name.
